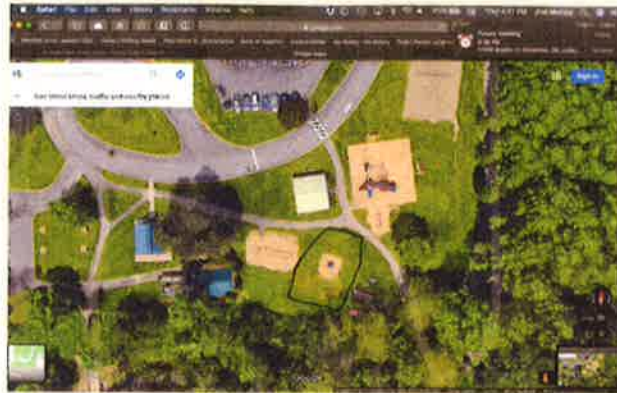

THE STORY:

NAMING RIGHTS TO THE PARK: \$10,000.00

This allows the donor to name the park after someone they care about or after their family. Naming rights to the park will be prominently placed so all can see.

MAJOR DONOR: \$1,000.00

Every person who donates \$1,000.00 will have their name placed on a permanent sign to be placed at the park in perpetuity.

NAMING RIGHTS TO A PIECE OF EQUIPMENT: \$5,000.00

This will allow the donor to have their name prominently placed on the play structure of their choice.

DONOR: \$100.00

Every donor who donates \$100.00 will have their name placed on a Brick to be placed in the park.

NAMING RIGHTS TO 1 OF 2 BENCHES: \$2,500.00

This will allow the donor to have naming rights to one of two benches that are planned for the play area.

FRIENDS OF THE PARK: \$1 TO \$99

Donors will have the knowledge that they are part of a project that will provide a playground for kids of all ages and abilities.
